


# Full Circle, Dan Compton, Woody Lane at Suttle Lake Weekend

PCDC fills out this year's Fall Weekend at Suttle Lake with some of Oregon's finest performers. (Camp is September 15-17; there may still be some spaces left—check with the camp registrar, Norman Hale, 503 /236-8062.)

Full Circle is George Penk, Heather Pinney, and Fred Nussbaum. They've been delighting both Contra and English Country dancers throughout the Northwest since 1987. George mixes the sublime with the gutsy on fiddle, while Heather divides her time between



piano and heavenly fiddle harmonies. Fred, on cello, alternates between resonant counter-melodies and holding the bottom together. At Suttle, Full Circle will play for the English Country Dance sessions.



Woody Lane learned both clogging and calling in West Virginia in the late '70's. Since moving to Roseburg five years ago, he has developed quite the local reputation as a caller. Woody's clogging teams over the past 15 years have included the Limberjacks, the Heart & Sole Cloggers, the Barking Frog Cloggers, and the Kickapoo Cloggers. Woody will teach a pair of clogging workshops (and just maybe a team-naming class!) at Suttle Lake.

Dan Compton's fiddling focuses on the traditional music of Ireland, Quebec, and Appalachia. After a number of trips

to Ireland, he has developed a fondness for the fiddle styles of Counties Clare and Kerry, as well as for playing music into the wee hours (which proclivities have paid off in more ways than one: Dan met his wife Fran at 4 am at a music festival in Donegal). Dan has played with numerous Northwest bands, currently including Jigsaw and the Boomchuck String Quartet. At Suttle, he'll be mainly in Appalachian mode for Woody's clogging classes.
