Finances will continue to be on the agenda for upcoming board meetings. The person who was warned about her inappropriate behavior at a dance came to express her concerns about how her situation had been handled by the board.

PCDC September Board Meeting Minutes (digest). Dave Smith and the Lundbergs will lead a music workshop in October. Plans for the English Ball are well underway. PCDC T-shirts will be sold at Suttle Lake camp. A dancer wrote a letter to the board to complain about the use of a lottery for Suttle this year. Barb suggested, and the board approved, some policy clarifications and changes for the newsletter—all original material appearing in the newsletter becomes the property of PCDC; reprinting/redistribution of such material requires board approval; the newsletter will be reviewed by a board committee prior to printing.
