on his flutes, tinwhistle, oboe, saxophone and bombard.

This past year, he appeared on NPR's All Things Considered with his band, The Sevens. He is currently also a member of The Sevens and the Ohio based Hotpoint String Band.

## **Portland Dance Honors Contra Dance Legend**

We are in for a special treat November 19th as callers, musicians, and dancers come together to honor the legacy of Ted Sannella. Dan Compton and Fran Slefer will host this special event in place of the usual third Saturday event. The dancing will start as usual at 8 pm. at the Fulton Center, with teaching at 7:30 pm.

Sannella died ten years ago this month, and the idea for a special dance honoring his significant contribution to American dance came from local caller and Country Dance and Song Society president Mary Devlin. "Ted not only wrote a ton of really good contras, squares, and triplets that are still being danced, says Mary, "but he was also a mentor to a great many callers". Paul McCullough, who will lead dances that evening along with Mary, also credits Sannella with fostering his work as a caller. Sannella, a native of Massachusetts, wrote three books on folk dancing and called dances in five countries, but he also had Portland connections. He was a guest caller at the Suttle Lake dance camp where music was provided by none other than Jigsaw, the band that will play for us on November 19th. And yes, according to Mary, the evening will include some of Ted's famous numbered triplets! (Newbies, tradition dictates that you whoop and holler when the caller announces a triplet number, for example, "Ted's Triplet #22", no matter what the number is.)

Join the 3rd Saturday contra dance crew on November 19th for a fun and enlightening evening honoring a contra dance legend.
